



2020 JUNIOR TASTER COURSE APPLICATION FORM

This years Junior Taster Course runs from Monday 20th to Friday 24th July 2020 inclusive.

***Like last year, priority will be given to paid up members but please note that even for members, allocation of places is on a first come first serve basis as it is possible that the numbers applying may exceed the available places.**

The course is open to children between the ages of 7 and 10. Children **MUST** be 7 yrs of age at the time of the course.

Half Day Course

This is run over the five days and is broken into two groups - one at **10 am to 1 pm** and the other between **2 pm and 5 pm**. The course is very 'fun focused' and has proven to be a gentle fun way for kids to get involved in sailing.

Places are limited and last year we had a waiting list for all our junior taster courses.

The cost of the half day course is €125 for paid up members and €170 for non members.

Baltimore Sailing Club will provide boats for children on the half day courses, but if a child has access to their own boat to use for the half day course this would be very helpful to the club. The half day course is based on one instructor and two children sharing one boat.

Full Day Course (Must be 9 years old before 31st October 2020)

We also run a full day course for more experienced sailors who have done a half day taster before as a stepping stone to the Irish Sailing Level 1 (Start Sailing) Course. Successful participants of this course receive the Irish Sailing "Taste of Sailing" certificate.

The cost of this full day course (run over five days) is €170 for BSC members and €210 for non-members. Places are **very limited** on this course and priority will be given to paid up members (*see note above).

Full day course participants **must** have their own boat or a place in a boat. This must be a suitable boat for the course. Please fill in boat information on the form.

*Please note that children attending the full day course are required to be collected by Parents/Guardian's during the lunchtime breaks (1 - 2 pm).

Participating children are not the responsibility of Baltimore Sailing Club or the Sailing Instructors during lunchtime break. Children must not be on club property during non-course times due to insurance restrictions.

Full day course students who have their own boat must have **pleasure craft/marine insurance** with third party cover of min. € 3,000,000.

Registration for all three groups will take place at 9:30 am on Monday 20th July in the Sailing Club.

NOTE Cancellation Policy - Cancellations for the Taster course prior to the 1st May will be given a refund of 60% of the total course fee. Thereafter no refund will apply except in the event of a medically certified case whereupon a 50% refund will apply.

Payment

This year payment will not be collected until after your child's place on the course is confirmed. Please do not pay in advance as it will not secure a place.
