Candidate availability

The proposed course dates are as follows:

Due to the Coronavirus outbreak the proposed dates for the courses may have to change. We may have to completely cancel courses, move the start date or change the length of the course. It is important, therefore, that you indicate all the times you will be available during the summer months.

Selection Criteria

It may be necessary to interview for some positions if we have a similar level of experience and the position is oversubscribed. The Club especially welcomes applications from members who have shown a willingness and ability to assist in the club on a voluntary basis in the past.

Assistant Boat Steward Summer 2021

Reports to:

- Commodore
- Senior Boat Steward
- Senior Instructor
- Junior Organiser

Responsibilities:

- Pre season preparation of Ribs and Club boats (Topaz, Stratos, 1720)
- Routine maintenance of Ribs and Club boats
- Launch and retrieval of Ribs
- Refueling of Ribs
- Maintenance and charging of VHF's
- Provide safety boat services as needed to sailing courses, racing days and key club events (eg Rambler, 1720 Nationals etc)
- Mark laying for Saturday racing, Events and Sailing courses
- Help in making sure the club and facilities are in good condition on ongoing basis
- Provide advice/help where possible to instructors and parents on damaged boats
- Flexibility required around helping club stewards/ club manager where necessary
- Ensure access to club entrances and exits clear at all times

Requirements:

- Certificates required
 - ISA Instructor Cert
 - Powerboat 2
 - First Aid / Emergency Care (covering CPR and cold water immersion)
 - Sport Ireland Safeguarding Cert 1
 - Garda Vetting Clearance
- Candidates must be at least 17 years of age
- Advanced Instructors in addition require:
 - Advanced Instructor Cert
 - Safety Boat
 - VHF

Preference will be given to candidates who are actively involved in sailing on an ongoing basis.

- Certificates required
 - o ISA Senior Instructor Cert
 - o Safety Boat
 - o VHF
 - o First Aid / Emergency Care (covering CPR and cold water immersion)
 - o Sport Ireland Safeguarding Cert 1
 - o Garda Vetting Clearance
- Candidates must be at least 19 years of age

Candidates should have an interest, ability and experience in sailing and seamanship together with a calm demeanour and a patient and pleasant personality.
